BIG BINGO GAME CONDITIONS and PRIZE STRUCTURE STATEMENT

1) RULES AND REGULATIONS

BIG Bingo is governed by the Rules and Regulations Respecting Bingo Games of the British Columbia Lottery Corporation ("BCLC") which include limitations of liability and are available from BCLC upon request.

2) DESCRIPTION

BIG Bingo is an electronic bingo game conducted at the times and places designated by BCLC.

BIG Bingo is played on an electronic non-traditional bingo card having a 3 x 3 square configuration (a "Card") which is only available in multiples of three. The three columns on a Card are labeled: "B", "I", and "G". The numbers under the columns of each Card are randomly generated as follows:

Under the "B" – 1 through 15 inclusive, Under the "I" – 16 through 30 inclusive, and Under the "G" – 46 through 60 inclusive.

3) PLAY CREDITS

To be eligible to participate in a BIG Bingo Game, a player must purchase play credits that are recorded into an electronic bingo account as follows:

- a) The player chooses a player identification number ("PIN") associated to the electronic bingo account and must enter that number into the electronic bingo terminal to activate play credits;
- b) The player may purchase additional play credits to be added to the amount in their electronic bingo account; and
- c) The player may redeem some or all play credits remaining in their electronic bingo account for cash by providing either the electronic bingo slip or their account number and entering their PIN, but can only redeem such play credits before the end of business on the day of purchase.

4) PLAY

After obtaining an electronic bingo slip, the player selects an unoccupied terminal and enters their PIN on the terminal screen (the "Screen"). If the player chooses bingo from the menu and BIG Bingo is the next available game in the bingo category, the player may select the number of Cards to be played. BCLC and the gaming facility operator may set a maximum number of Cards that can be played by an individual player. Players may exchange Cards prior to the start of the BIG Bingo Game. Each Card is valid for a complete BIG Bingo Game.

5) DRAW

For each BIG Bingo Game, 45 bingo numbers will be pre-drawn by random number generation from numbers B1 to B15, I16 to I30, and G46 to G60, inclusive. Bingo numbers are called and displayed on the Screen one at a time in the order drawn.

One BIG Bingo Game consists of at least six (6) bingo patterns (a "BIG Bingo Game") as follows:

- i. A bingo pattern as prescribed by BCLC ("Pari-mutuel Part 1");
- ii. A bingo pattern as prescribed by BCLC ("Pari-mutuel Part 2");
- Full card Jackpot in 12 numbers called or less. ("Level 1 Jackpot");
- Full card Jackpot in 13 to 14 numbers called. ("Level 2 Jackpot");
- v. Full card Jackpot in 15 to 16 numbers called. ("Level 3 Jackpot");
- vi. Full Card Consolation or other pattern prescribed by BCLC ("Consolation").

A BIG Bingo Game may also include a bonus bingo game ("**Bonus**") or contingency bingo game ("**Contingency**") as determined by BCLC.

- a) A BIG Bingo Game is not linked to BIG Bingo play at other gaming facilities. A Bonus game or Contingency may, at the sole discretion of BCLC, be played at one, some, or all participating gaming facilities.
- b) A player must electronically mark bingo numbers on their Cards that match bingo numbers that are drawn and called.

6) WINNING CARDS

- a. A winner is declared for each pattern of a BIG Bingo Game when the conditions described below have been met:
 - i. For a Pari-mutuel pattern:
 - (1) The player must correctly match the prescribed bingo pattern on any (1) Card; and
 - (2) The player must communicate that he or she has bingo by electronically marking the number called before the next bingo number is called; and
 - (3) The Card has been verified as a winning card.
 - ii. For a Jackpot patterns:
 - (1) The player must correctly match the prescribed pattern on any one (1) Card within the predetermined number of bingo numbers called and displayed; and



- (2) The player must communicate that he or she has bingo by electronically marking the number called before the next bingo number is called; and
- (3) The Card has been verified as a winning card.

After the final Jackpot pattern has been closed when the prescribed number of drawn bingo numbers has been called and displayed, and there is no winning Card, the BIG Bingo Game will continue to the Consolation.

iii. For a Consolation:

- The player has correctly matched the pattern as prescribed by BCLC on any one
 Card by matching the bingo numbers drawn and called; and
- (2) The player must communicate that he or she has bingo by electronically marking the number called before the next bingo number is called; and
- (3) The bingo card has been verified as a winning Card.

When a winning Card for the Consolation at any gaming facility is verified, that BIG Bingo Game will be closed and the holder(s) of the winning Card(s) win or share the Consolation prize for that BIG Bingo Game. In the event that a Jackpot prize is won, there is no Consolation and the Consolation prize is added to the Jackpot prize.

- b. Subject to Sections 6(e) and 6(f) when a player communicates that he or she has "Bingo", no further bingo numbers will be called until either a winning Card has been confirmed or it is determined that there is no winning Card.
- c) It is the player's responsibility to declare "bingo" by electronically marking each number called before the next bingo number is called and that the caller/coordinator at the gaming facility becomes aware of the declaration and stops the BIG Bingo Game before the next bingo number is called.
- d) After a winning bingo Card has been verified, that portion of the BIG Bingo Game is closed and any prize(s) won are displayed at the relevant gaming facility. No further claim for any prize in a BIG Bingo Game may be made after the BIG Bingo Game or that portion thereof has been declared closed.
- e) If a player has matched the pattern as prescribed by BCLC on a bingo card and has a winning Card, but has not communicated "bingo" to the caller/coordinator at the gaming facility, then that BIG Bingo Game will continue and additional bingo numbers shall be called. A player who communicates "bingo" after any additional drawn bingo numbers have been called will share the prize for that bingo game with all other player(s), if any, who become winners as a result of additional bingo numbers being called.
- f) If a player does not communicate that she or he has bingo by electronically marking their Card before the next number is drawn, the player will be disqualified from claiming the Jackpot prize associated to the level that would have been won had communication been made.



7) PRIZES

a. Prizes are determined as follows:

Pari-mutuel Part 2	A percentage of BIG Bingo sales at the gaming facility where the BIG Bingo Game is played.	Prize pool or Share (1)
Jackpot	Every gaming facility that offers BIG Bingo will contribute to the Jackpot pool ("Jackpot Pool") that is managed by BCLC.	 Level 1 Jackpot Blackout in 12 numbers or less will pay \$100,000.00, plus the applicable Consolation prize or share. Level 2 Jackpot Blackout in 13 or 14 numbers will pay \$10,000.00 plus the applicable Consolation prize or share. Level 3 Jackpot Blackout in 15 or 16 numbers will pay \$1,000.00 plus the applicable Consolation prize or share.
Consolation	A percentage of BIG Bingo sales at the gaming facility where the BIG Bingo Game is played.	Prize pool or Share ⁽¹⁾ unless a Jackpot prize is won in which case the Consolation prize is added to the Jackpot prize and the Consolation will not be played.
Bonus or Contingency	As determined by BCLC, if BCLC chooses to offer Bonus or Contingency.	Share ⁽¹⁾ of Contingency or Bonus Prize as determined by BCLC.

^{(1) &}quot;Share" means the prize for that category is divided by the number of winning Cards in that category at the gaming facility where the BIG Bingo Game was played.



- b. i. A winning Card that wins a Jackpot prize will also win the Consolation prize associated to the same BIG Bingo Game.
 - ii. Any Card that wins a prize in the Pari-mutuel patterns is eligible to win a prize in the Jackpot or Consolation subject to Section 7(b)(i).

8) PRIZE CLAIMS

All prizes must be accepted as awarded. Pari-mutuel and Consolation prizes must be claimed at the gaming facility where the winning bingo Card was purchased before the close of business on the date such Card was issued. Jackpot prizes up to and including \$1,000.00 must be claimed when the Card is officially confirmed as a winning Card. Where a Jackpot prize exceeds \$1,000.00, the player has up to one year to claim the prize once the Card has been officially confirmed. To claim the prize, the player must present both a completed Cashier's Slip and a completed BIG Bingo Prize Claim Form (including a signed Representation, Indemnity and Release Agreement) to a BCLC Prize Payout Office.

9) LIMITATIONS

- a. Winning Cards must be verified and confirmed at the gaming facility where the winning Card was issued.
- b. A Card must be played at the gaming facility where such Card was issued. Only the bingo numbers and Cards recorded as issued in the computer system and not cancelled will participate in the applicable BIG Bingo Game.
- c. If a player who declared that he or she has "bingo" for a particular bingo game does not have a winning Card, that pattern play forming part of the BIG Bingo Game shall continue.
- d. To win any prize during the BIG Bingo Game, the player must be present in the gaming facility to communicate that he or she has "bingo".

10) GAME DELIVERY SYSTEM FAILURE OR MALFUNCTION

a. If, for any reason(s), a BIG Bingo Game malfunctions or is not received either in whole or in part at a gaming facility, the players at that gaming facility cannot participate in that BIG Bingo Game and all Cards issued at that gaming facility for that game are void. In such event, the service provider shall cancel the BIG Bingo Game and will refund each player the price of the Cards held by such player.



b. In the event the player is unable to communicate bingo by electronic marking, the player must make notification in such a manner that the caller/coordinator at the gaming facility is aware of the communication and stops the BIG Bingo Game before the next bingo number is called.
