## POKER LOTTO GAME CONDITIONS AND PRIZE STRUCTURE STATEMENT



#### 1. RULES AND REGULATIONS

Poker Lotto is governed by the Rules and Regulations Respecting Lotteries and Gaming (the "Rules") of British Columbia Lottery Corporation ("BCLC"), which include limitations of liability and are available upon request.

#### 2. ISSUANCE OF TICKETS

To participate, a player must request a Poker Lotto ticket (a "Ticket") from an authorized retailer, or BCLC, where applicable, and pay the required amount. Each Ticket is comprised of one, two, or three hands, as requested by the player. A hand is five (5) cards (a "Hand") randomly generated from a standard 52 card deck comprised of 13 cards (2 through 10, jack, queen, king, and ace) in four suits (diamonds, clubs, hearts, and spades) (a "Deck"). Each Hand costs \$2.00. Upon receipt of payment, the Ticket, as further defined by the Rules, will be issued showing: the draw date; the Hand(s); the amount wagered; the control number; and other relevant information.

#### 3. GAME DAY

The Game Day commences on or about 11:05 p.m. PT and ends on or about 11:00 p.m. PT the following calendar date.

#### 4. PLAY

Poker Lotto consists of two components: an instant play component ("Instant Play") and a draw component ("Draw Play").

#### **4.1. INSTANT PLAY AND PRIZES**

(a) Once a Ticket is issued, the Hand(s) are displayed on the Player Display Unit ("**PDU**"). If a Hand contains the cards that make up one of the Poker Hands as set out in the table below, the player wins the corresponding prize.

Note:

- 1. An ace can be used in both a low straight (A, 2, 3, 4, 5) and a high straight (10, J, Q, K, A).
- In a Royal Flush, Straight Flush, or Flush, the suit of each card in a Hand must be of the same suit, whether all hearts, all spades, all diamonds, or all clubs, to be a winning Hand. The suits of the cards in the other Poker Hands are not relevant for the purposes of winning an Instant Play prize.
- (b) Only one Instant Play prize per Hand may be won, that prize being the top-ranked Instant Play prize available to that Hand.
- (c) Winning Instant Play Tickets may be redeemed for the Instant Play prize before the Draw Play corresponding to that Ticket. When a winning Instant Play Ticket is redeemed before the Draw Play, BCLC shall issue the player an exchange ticket for the corresponding Draw Play containing the same Hand(s) as displayed on the original Ticket and the original Ticket will, upon issuance of such exchange ticket, become void. For further clarity, the exchange ticket is eligible to win an additional prize in the Draw Play.
- (d) If a player checks a non-winning Instant Play Ticket before the Draw Play corresponding to that Ticket, the player will:
  - If at a self-service check-a-ticket, receive a message on the check-a-ticket screen telling the player that the Ticket is not a winner but that there are draws remaining. The Ticket remains eligible to win a prize in the Draw Play.
  - 2. If at a retailer, the player will see a message on the PDU telling the player that the Ticket is not a winner but that there are draws remaining, and the player will receive from the retailer the player's original Ticket as well as a slip stating that there was no Instant Win and "Good Luck" on the draw. The original Ticket remains eligible to win a prize in the Draw Play.

#### 4.2. DRAW PLAY AND PRIZES

- (a) Unless otherwise announced by BCLC, BCLC shall cause to be drawn each Game Day five (5) randomly generated cards (the "**Drawn Cards**") from a Deck. The Drawn Cards are the winning cards for that Game Day's Draw Play.
- (b) A Ticket is a winning ticket for the Draw Play if 2, 3, 4, or 5 cards in a Hand exactly match, in rank and suit, the Drawn Cards as set out in the table below, and the player wins the corresponding prize.

(c) Only one Draw Play prize per Hand may be won, that prize being the top-ranked Draw Play prize available to that Hand.

#### 5. PRIZE CLAIMS AND EXPIRATION OF TICKETS

- (a) Prizes must be accepted as awarded and must be claimed in the manner stated on the back of the Ticket within one year from the date of the draw day printed on the Ticket. Expired Tickets are void.
- (b) If any winning Ticket bears a Hand that differs from the Hand which is recorded in the computer system under the control number identifying such Ticket, then such Ticket shall not be void but shall conclusively be deemed to bear the Hand which is so recorded in the computer system.
