Re: Request for Records: BCLC File 19-032

British Columbia Lottery Corporation (BCLC) writes further to your March 27, 2019 request under B.C.'s Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FIPPA) and BCLC's letter dated March 27, 2019.

You requested:

"A copy of all correspondence between Greg Moore and Jim Lightbody, from Nov. 1, 2018 to present day [March 27, 2019]."

BCLC is providing six pages of records in response to your request. Some information has been withheld from disclosure under sections 13, 15, 16, 17 and 22 of FIPPA. An additional six pages have been withheld in their entirety under section 16 of FIPPA.

Below are the reasons for withholding information under each of the exceptions to disclosure noted.

Section 13 (policy advice or recommendations)

The information withheld under this section constitutes advice and recommendations to BCLC decision makers.

Section 15 (harm to law enforcement)

The information withheld under this section is harmful to law enforcement because, if disclosed, the information withheld under this section would harm law enforcement matters that are currently the subject of ongoing investigation.

Section 16 (harm to intergovernmental relations or negotiations)

The information withheld under this section is harmful to intergovernmental relations because disclosure would harm the conduct of relations between governmental agencies and would reveal information that was received in confidence from another government organization.

Section 17 (harm to the financial or economic interests of BCLC)

The information withheld under this section is harmful to BCLC's financial or economic interests because disclosure would reveal the private phone numbers of BCLC's President and CEO, which could necessitate changing the numbers with an associated cost to BCLC.

In addition, the information withheld under this section is harmful to BCLC's financial or economic interests because disclosure would reveal financial, commercial or technical information that belongs to BCLC and that has monetary value as well as plans, proposals or projects that have not yet been implemented or made public, the disclosure of which would result in undue financial loss to BCLC or gain to a third party.

Section 22 (harm to personal privacy)

The information withheld under this section consists of personal information that, if disclosed, would be an unreasonable invasion of the personal privacy of a third party.
