Re: Request for Records: BCLC File 20-035

British Columbia Lottery Corporation (BCLC) writes further to your June 17, 2020 request, received by BCLC on June 18, 2020, under B.C.'s *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (FIPPA) and BCLC's letter dated June 23, 2020.

Your original request was for:

"I am curious if anyone won 649 and/or bc49 as well as the extra at one time. I want this information from day 1. I also would like similar information for lottomax."

BCLC is interpreting your request to be for:

"Has anyone ever won the major prize on Lotto 6/49, BC/49 or Lotto Max, as well as the major prize on the Extra, on the same ticket?"

If this interpretation is not correct, please advise and clarify your request.

In order to assist you, BCLC's Freedom of Information department has made inquiries as to whether there might be any records responsive to your request. Several long-service BCLC employees have advised that this would have been a memorable event in BCLC's lottery history and no one recalls such an event ever occurring.

BCLC trusts that this answers your question. If not, BCLC can conduct a search for records. However, the time to search through a significant volume of historical records, in both paper and electronic format, would generate a fee estimate to you. BCLC would require a deposit before proceeding and the search would be unlikely to locate any responsive records.

If BCLC does not hear from you by **July 20, 2020**, it will assume that your information needs have been satisfied and your file will be closed.
