You requested:

"...a log of all player's playnow.com wins and losses for a given day. The data can be anonymized but the wins and losses of each player should be identifiable. Also, aggregated win loss percentages per game. Monthly or yearly stats are adequate."

BCLC interpreted your clarified request on January 8, 2019 to be for:

"A snapshot of one day (December 5, 2018) of data for every game on PlayNow.com broken down by individual anonymized player, win amounts and loss amounts."

In accordance with section 6(2) of FIPPA, BCLC has created a record in response to your request and is withholding that record in its entirety under section 17(1) of FIPPA.

If disclosed, the information could reasonably be expected to harm the financial or economic interests of BCLC and could reasonably be expected to result in undue financial gain to a third party. This is because the data is commercially valuable and can be used by BCLC's competitors. As such, disclosure of the information could reasonably result in a loss of revenue to BCLC.
