

RULES AND REGULATIONS RESPECTING JACKPOT ENTITLEMENT FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE PARTICIPANTS IN BCLC'S VOLUNTARY SELF-EXCLUSION PROGRAM

British Columbia Lottery Corporation ("BCLC") is authorized by and as agent for the Government of British Columbia to conduct, manage and operate lottery schemes pursuant to the *Gaming Control Act* of the Province of British Columbia (the "Act").

INTERPRETATION

- 1. In these Rules and Regulations:
 - a. "Committee" means an individual who has been awarded committeeship of a Vulnerable Adult by a court of competent jurisdiction pursuant to the *Patients Property Act*;
 - b. "Gaming Facility" has the same meaning as it has in s.1 of the Act;
 - c. "Gaming Facility Prize" means any prize or winnings, gross or net, arising as a result of participation in gaming or events held at Gaming Facilities;
 - d. "PlayNow.com Prize" means any prize or winnings, gross or net, arising as a result of participation in gaming or events through PlayNow.com;
 - e. "VSE Individual" means an enrollee in BCLC's VSE Program;
 - f. "VSE Program" (also referred to as Voluntary Self-Exclusion program) means a program offered by BCLC whereby individuals can enroll to voluntarily exclude themselves from certain Gaming Facilities and/or PlayNow.com for certain periods of time; and
 - g. "Vulnerable Adult" is an individual deemed unable to manage their affairs by a court of competent jurisdiction pursuant to the *Patients Property Act*.

ENTITLEMENT

 VSE Individuals who have voluntary excluded themselves from Gaming Facilities are not eligible to receive a Gaming Facility Prize at such Gaming Facilities.

- 2. VSE Individuals who have voluntary excluded themselves from PlayNow.com are not eligible to receive a PlayNow.com Prize.
- 3. A Committee may enroll a Vulnerable Adult in the VSE Program.
- 4. The completion of a VSE Program enrollment form for Gaming Facilities by a VSE Individual, or a Committee on behalf of a Vulnerable Adult, constitutes both the notice itself and delivery of said notice as required by s. 92(b) of the Act.
