

While it is still early in our social-purpose journey, our commitment to corporate citizenship — through player health; employee, community and stakeholder engagement; diversity and inclusion; and environmental sustainability — has never been stronger.

BCLC's social purpose is the north star that guides our organization to continue being a positive force for good.

Each year, local governments in B.C. that host a gambling facility receive a 10 per cent share of the net gaming income those facilities generate. Last year, 32 Host Local Governments across B.C. received **\$66.9 million** in provincial gambling revenue to fund local projects and initiatives

KAMLOOPS FOOD BANK

Volunteers from Cascades Casino Kamloops support the Kamloops Food bank each week, putting together bags to send home with local Kamloops students who may not have enough food for the weekend. The Starfish Pack Program started with only a handful of backpacks several years ago and has grown to 144 backpacks per week across 14 Kamloops schools.

PLAYING IT FORWARD

IN KAMLOOPS

In 2019, the City of Kamloops undertook a multi-year phased project using gambling revenue from hosting Chances Kamloops and Cascades Casino Kamloops.

The McArthur Island Multi-Use Park Project was funded from 2019 to 2021, at a cost of just over \$1,000,000, funded entirely from gambling revenue. The old golf course on McArthur Island was transformed in three phases to a public natural park environment. Features of the park include a disc-golf course, and user amenities such as washrooms, park furniture, pedestrian bridges, and a picnic shelter — all in a natural playground.
