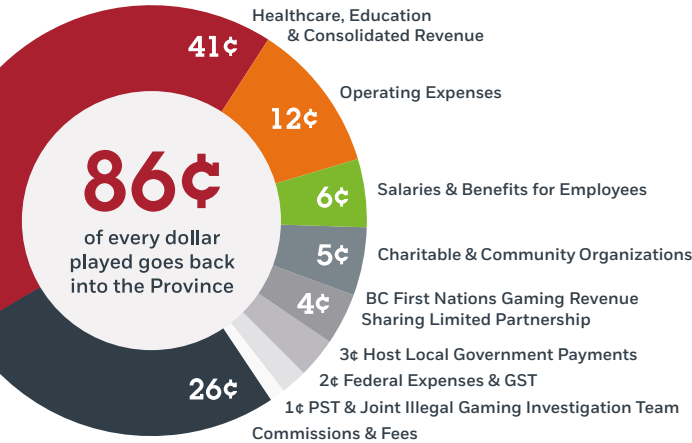

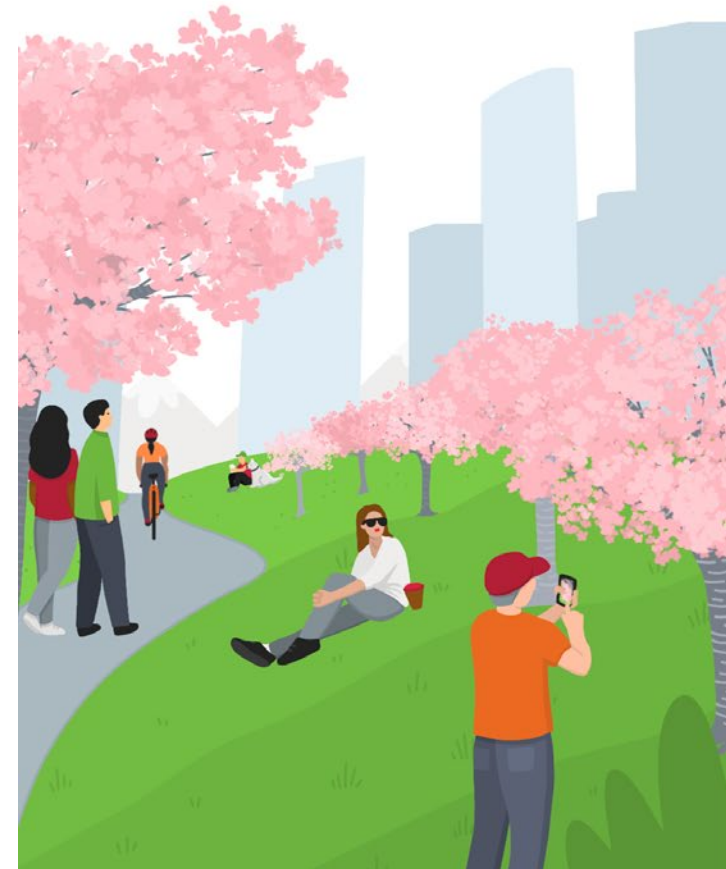

Each year, municipal and First Nations governments in B.C. that host a gambling facility typically receive a 10 per cent share of net gambling income generated at those facilities. In fiscal year 2023/24, BCLC generated \$94.5 million for the Province to distribute to 33 Host Local Governments across B.C. to fund local projects and initiatives.

In 2023, River Rock Casino Resort administered donations to 20 different organizations, including Richmond Cares, Richmond Gives, Richmond Hospital Foundation, and Richmond Food Bank. River Rock also supported nearly 40 other organizations through in-kind donations of hotel stays and hospitality gift certificates including Richmond Women's Resource Centre, Musqueam Canoe Club, and the Domenic Mobilio Foundation.

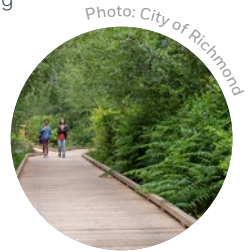

RICHMOND BENEFITS

In 2023, the City of Richmond used a portion of its provincial gambling revenue from hosting River Rock Casino to finance several large-scale capital improvement projects.

Among these were significant infrastructure renewals at the Richmond Ice Centre and Watermania, ensuring these facilities remain state-of-the-art and serve the community's recreational needs. Additionally, the funding supported ongoing improvements to the Richmond Nature Park, enhancing its natural beauty and visitor experience, and restoration work at the historic Britannia Shipyards, preserving an important piece of the city's maritime heritage.

The casino revenue also enabled the City of Richmond to purchase a street-sweeping machine specifically for bike lanes, significantly improving cyclist safety throughout the city. This investment reflects Richmond's commitment to promoting sustainable transportation and ensuring the well-being of its residents. Furthermore, the funds supported the citywide replacement and rehabilitation of sidewalks, street lights, and connector walkways, enhancing the overall infrastructure and ensuring safer and more accessible pathways for pedestrians and cyclists alike.
