Maple Ridge Benefits

The Province of B.C. created BCLC 40 years ago with the purpose of giving back to British Columbians and to help communities grow. Since that time, thanks to our players, BCLC has delivered \$30 billion in net income back to the province to support communities, provincial programs and essential services that we all rely on.

Municipalities and First Nations that host gambling facilities typically receive a 10 per cent share of the net revenue those facilities generate. Since 2013, the City of Maple Ridge has received more than \$17.42 million in Host Local Government payments. Last year, the City of Maple Ridge received \$1.49 million generated by Chances Maple Ridge.
