Vancouver Benefits

In 2024, Parq Casino supported several community organizations through partnerships and donations. Notable partners included YWCA Metro Vancouver, Vancouver Chinatown Foundation, Downtown Eastside Women's Centre, and the St. Paul's Foundation

Parq also contributed to the local economy by sourcing products from Vancouver vendors such as Buckhead Meats & Seafood, Jim M Koo Produce Ltd, La Baguette & l'Echalote, and Yamato Trading.

Did You Know?

Hastings Racecourse funds several key initiatives annually: \$500,000 to the Greening of Hastings Park project, \$240,000 to subsidize 44 spaces at an on-site Child Care Facility, \$100,000 through a long-term Community Legacy Fund, and \$20,000 to operate the Race Horse Groom School, offering local industry training.

LOCAL IMPACT

Community Support

In 2024, Hastings Racecourse & Casino supported a wide range of local organizations and initiatives through its Community Benefits Agreement with the City of Vancouver, totaling \$925,000 in annual commitment.

As part of its Community Days program, Hastings hosted 10 local charities, each receiving a \$5,000 donation and \$1,500 in food and beverage support to hold a fundraiser during a race day. The 2024 recipients included the Greater Vancouver Food Bank, Employ to Empower Foundation, Mamas for Mamas, New Stride Thoroughbred Adoption Society, PuSH International Performing Arts Society, KidSport BC, Urban Ink Production Society, Ronald McDonald House, Variety Club BC, and the United Rugby Club.

Other donations included \$2,800 to the Greater Vancouver Food Bank and \$3,000 to Employ to Empower. The racecourse also supported the Food Bank's 50/50 draws, helping raise \$44,000 during race events.
