Each year, municipal and First Nations governments in B.C. that host a gambling facility typically receive a 10 per cent share of net gambling income generated at those facilities. In fiscal year 2024/25, BCLC generated **\$86.6 million** for the Province to distribute to 33 Host Local Governments across B.C. to fund local projects and initiatives.

## GAMBLING REVENUE

### Funds Local Initiatives in Greater Victoria

Last year, the Province of B.C. allocated more than \$140 million to not-for-profit organizations through the Community Gaming Grants program.

### Victoria Hospitals Foundation Visions Gala

In 2024, BCLC proudly sponsored the Victoria Hospitals Foundation's Visions Gala, a signature black-tie event that raised \$2.75 million to support surgical innovation at Royal Jubilee and Victoria General hospitals. The gala, attended by more than 620 philanthropists, caregivers, and healthcare leaders, marked a milestone in the Foundation's multi-million-dollar campaign to bring advanced surgical robotics and cutting-edge equipment to Vancouver Island.

## YOU PLAY

### View Royal Benefits

In 2024, the Town of View Royal allocated its share of provincial gambling revenue from hosting Casino Victoria to a variety of municipal projects. These initiatives included:

- Support for WestShore Parks and Recreation
- Technology upgrades, including server replacements and improvements to information systems
- Traffic signal and sidewalk upgrades along Island Highway
- Street lighting improvements on St. Giles Street
- Playground equipment replacement at Knollwood Park
- Trail improvements at Glentana Trail
- Public safety investments, including the replacement of a brush truck and installation of firefighting gear decontamination facilities

## SPONSORSHIP

### Community Support

In 2024, Casino Victoria supported a wide range of local organizations through charitable donations, in-kind contributions, and sponsorships. A total of \$36,000 in cash donations was distributed to community groups including the Goldstream Food Bank, Canadian Mental Health Association BC, Crohn's and Colitis Canada, Victoria Hospitals Foundation, Our Place Society, and Island Kids Cancer Association, and others.

The casino also provided in-kind prizes—such as free play, dinner vouchers, and merchandise—to many local organizations including the Victoria Nikkei Cultural Society, Greater Victoria Chamber of Commerce, and Victoria Hospice. In addition, Casino Victoria has donated over 1,200 decks of playing cards to different community groups.

Casino Victoria also sponsored local fundraising events, including \$2,000 for the Fairway Gorge Paddling Club and \$1,000 for a Curl BC event, further contributing to community-focused initiatives in the region.
