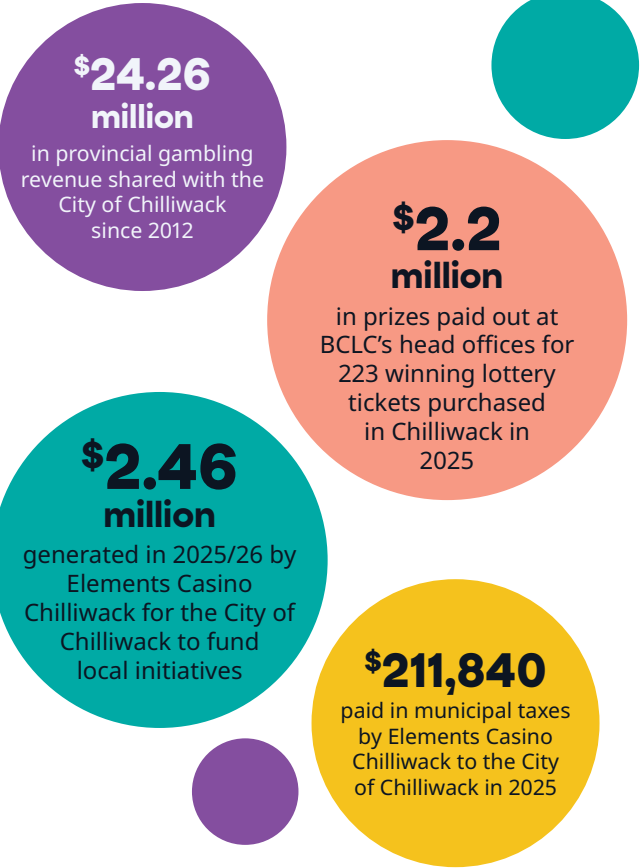

Each year, municipal and First Nations governments in B.C. that host a gambling facility typically receive a 10 per cent share of net gambling income generated at those facilities. In fiscal year 2025/26, BCLC generated \$83.4 million for the Province to distribute to 33 Host Local Governments across B.C. to fund local projects and initiatives.

GAMBLING REVENUE

Funds Local Initiatives in Chilliwack

Last year, the Province of B.C. allocated \$140 million to not-for-profit organizations through the Community Gaming Grants program.

LOCAL IMPACT

Community Support

Elements Casino Chilliwack contributed \$104,886.30 directly to community organizations in 2025. Notable sponsorships included their signature partnership with Chilliwack Bowls of Hope (\$11,778), \$3,500 for the Chamber Yearly Excellence Awards Non-Profit Award, \$3,500 for the Community Business Excellence Awards, \$3,000 for the Chilliwack Hospice Hoedown, \$1,500 for the Downtown Vintage Car Show, \$1,500 for the Rotary Christmas Parade, and more. Additional support was provided to Pacific Autism Family Centre, Chilliwack Hospital Foundation, Ann Davis Transition Society, Community Angels Food and Housing Support Society, Downtown Chilliwack BIA, Ruth & Naomi's Mission, and Chilliwack Flight Fest Society.

In-kind contributions included 42 donations valued at \$39,602, including items such as event packages and goods used for fundraising activities. Elements Casino Chilliwack staff also led several fundraising initiatives including Jeans Day, coin drives, silent auctions, and an annual toy drive supporting Chilliwack Community Services that raised
