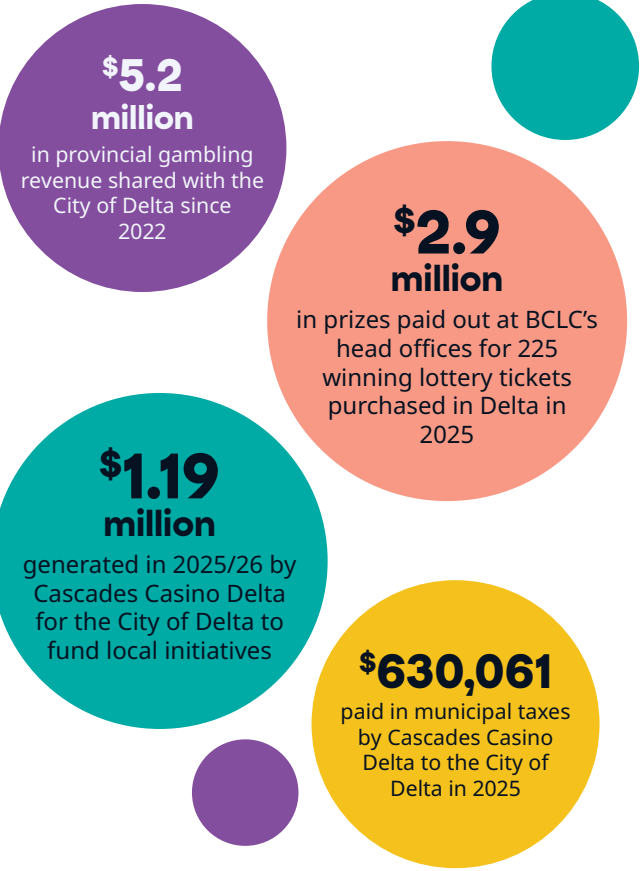

Each year, municipal and First Nations governments in B.C. that host a gambling facility typically receive a 10 per cent share of net gambling income generated at those facilities. In fiscal year 2025/26, BCLC generated \$83.4 million for the Province to distribute to 33 Host Local Governments across B.C. to fund local projects and initiatives.

GAMBLING REVENUE

Funds Local Initiatives in Delta

Last year, the Province of B.C. allocated \$140 million to not-for-profit organizations through the Community Gaming Grants program.

Delta Benefits

From the opening of Cascades Casino Delta in late 2022 through December 31, 2025, the City of Delta has received \$4,890,829 in net gambling income. These revenues have been transferred to the City's Casino Reserve Fund, where they are being held to support future municipal projects.

As of 2025, the reserve has now reached a level that can support initiatives aimed at enhancing livability and community well-being, including trail network expansion, accessibility improvements, and park infrastructure upgrades. Staff will engage with Delta Council on the potential use of these funds to advance key priorities identified during the 2027 budget process.

LOCAL IMPACT

Community Support

Cascades Casino Delta supported many community organizations in 2025, including Delta Community Foundation, Delta Hospital and Community Health Foundation, DeltAssist Family and Community Services Society, Reach Child and Youth Development Society, and Pacific Autism Family Network. Additional donations went to Guru Nanak Food Bank, Fiji Festival 2025, EarthWise Society, and True North Aid in support of Indigenous
