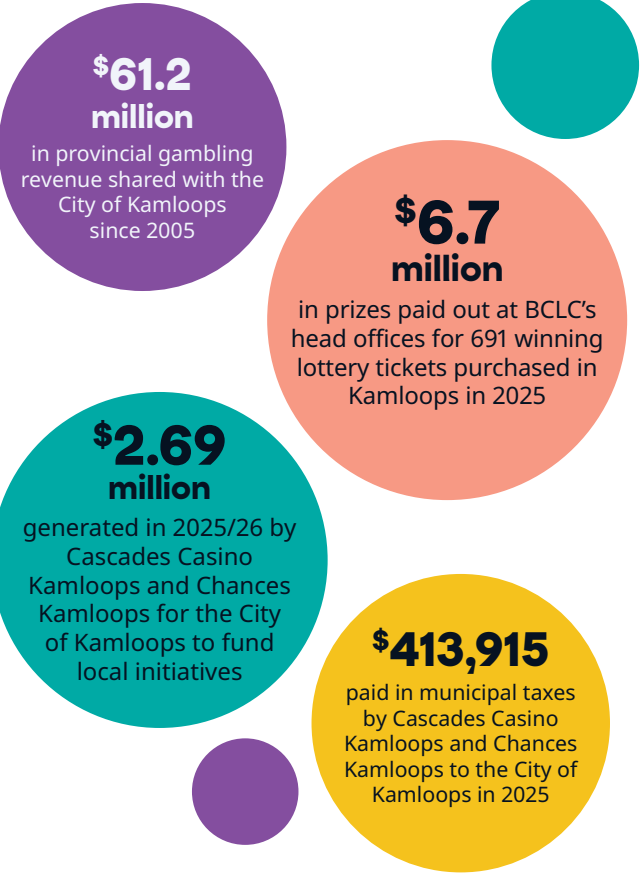

Each year, municipal and First Nations governments in B.C. that host a gambling facility typically receive a 10 per cent share of net gambling income generated at those facilities. In fiscal year 2025/26, BCLC generated \$83.4 million for the Province to distribute to 33 Host Local Governments across B.C. to fund local projects and initiatives.

GAMBLING REVENUE

Funds Local Initiatives in Kamloops

Last year, the Province of B.C. allocated \$140 million to not-for-profit organizations through the Community Gaming Grants program.



SPONSORSHIP

Kamloops Art Gallery

For the past ten years, BCLC has proudly sponsored Free Thursdays, covering admission to help make arts and culture accessible to everyone in our community.

In addition, Kamloops Art Gallery joined the BCLC Community Ticketing Program roster of partners in 2025. This program provides complimentary event tickets to local non-profits and charities as a way of recognizing their important work across British Columbia and bringing people together for shared moments of connection. In this first year, together, this initiative has connected more than 120 individuals from organizations like Smart Options, Pivot Point Family Growth Centre, Connective Support Society, and Immigrant Services with shared arts experiences, strengthening community connections and expanding access to culture.

YOU PLAY

Kamloops Benefits

In 2025, the City of Kamloops allocated its share of provincial gambling revenue to a variety of capital and community-focused initiatives. Funding included \$177,985 for the City's Digital Strategy (DES), including the implementation of online permit applications. The Seniors Centre parking lot project, identified in 2024 as part of the Build Kamloops Program, was completed with \$501,515 in gambling revenue support.

Additional projects included \$462,400 for the Lorne Street Rail Safety project, \$432,000 for the Community Outreach Support and Clean Team program, and \$111,873 for the purchase of a drone to support survey work. Provincial gambling revenue also supported public realm improvements through contributions of \$147,826 to the Kamloops Central Business Improvement Association (KCBIA) Public Realm program and \$19,642 to the North Shore Business Improvement Association Public Realm program.

LOCAL IMPACT

Community Support

Cascades Casino Kamloops and Chances Kamloops provided financial donations and sponsorship support to a range of local organizations and initiatives in 2025. Donations were made to the Kamloops Food Bank, Kamloops Brain Injury Association, KidSport, Royal Inland Hospital, Kamloops Film Society, and more.

Local Impact

In addition to supporting community initiatives, Cascades Casino Kamloops and Chances Kamloops also source supplies and services from a variety of local vendors. These include Eagleview Refrigeration, Iron Road Brewery, Shuswap Coffee Company, and Interior Fire Protection.
