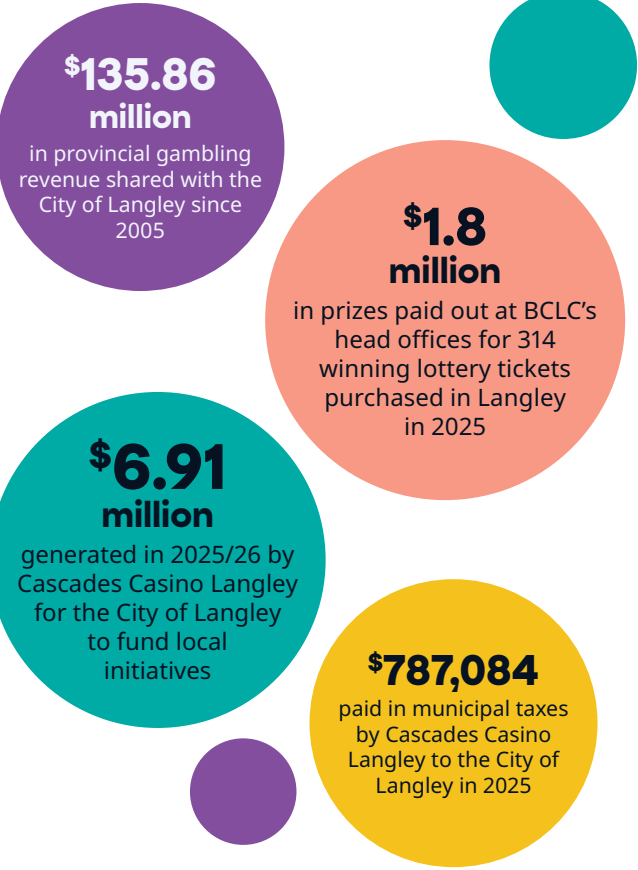

Each year, municipal and First Nations governments in B.C. that host a gambling facility typically receive a 10 per cent share of net gambling income generated at those facilities. In fiscal year 2025/26, BCLC generated \$83.4 million for the Province to distribute to 33 Host Local Governments across B.C. to fund local projects and initiatives.

GAMBLING REVENUE Funds Local Initiatives in Langley

Last year, the Province of B.C. allocated \$140 million to not-for-profit organizations through the Community Gaming Grants program.

Local Impact

In addition to supporting community initiatives, Cascades Casino Langley also sources supplies and services from more than 50 local vendors. These include Fresh Blooms Flowers, Vantage Mechanical, Mainland Fireplaces, Valley First Aid Training, and Inter City Refrigeration.

SPONSORSHIP Community Day

BCLC proudly supported Langley City's Community Day 2025, a signature summer celebration held at Douglas Park that brought together thousands of residents for a full day of community connection and entertainment. The free event featured live performances, food trucks, a bustling artisan and vendor marketplace, and a wide range of family-friendly activities including games, inflatables, and interactive community booths. Local organizations and cultural groups were also on site, helping to showcase services and celebrate the diversity and spirit of the Langley community.

YOU PLAY Langley Benefits

In 2025, the City of Langley allocated its share of provincial gambling revenue to a variety of capital infrastructure initiatives. Funding went to replace water and sewer infrastructure, and various enhancements to roads, sidewalks and multi-use paths. In 2026, the City of Langley has allocated funds toward a new Operations Centre building, along with an additional water infrastructure projects and ongoing improvements to roads, sidewalks, and greenways.

DID YOU KNOW Greater Good Giveaway

BCLC launched a new Scratch & Win ticket the "Greater Good Giveaway" which offers a Top Prize of \$10,000 for the winner and \$10,000 for their registered charity of choice, selected from a list of British Columbia charities on CanadaHelps. The ticket aligns strongly with our social purpose, to generate win-wins for the greater good, and we believe that when we share the wins, we are more connected to each other, our communities and our province.
