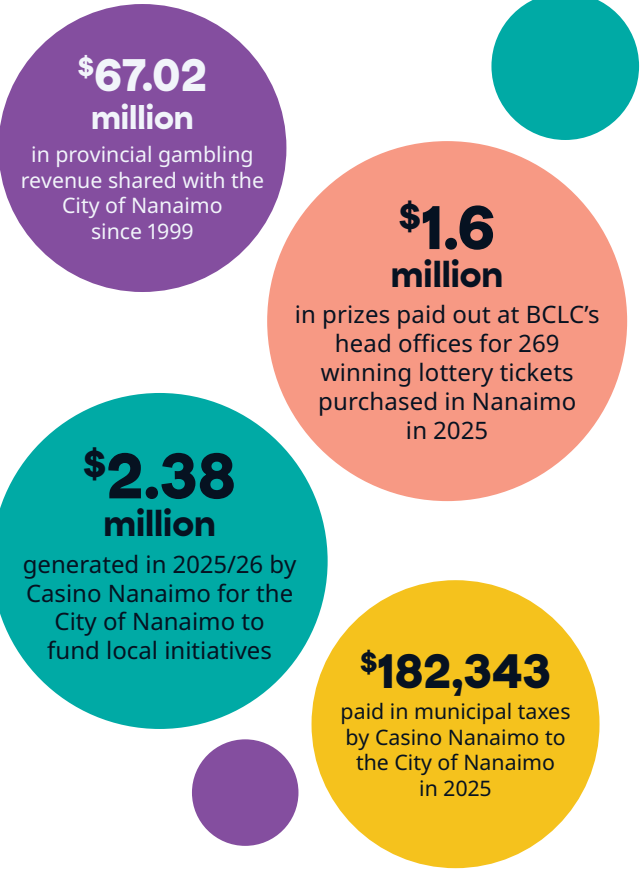

Each year, municipal and First Nations governments in B.C. that host a gambling facility typically receive a 10 per cent share of net gambling income generated at those facilities. In fiscal year 2025/26, BCLC generated \$83.4 million for the Province to distribute to 33 Host Local Governments across B.C. to fund local projects and initiatives.

GAMBLING REVENUE

Funds Local Initiatives in Nanaimo

Last year, the Province of B.C. allocated \$140 million to not-for-profit organizations through the Community Gaming Grants program.

Community Support

Casino Nanaimo provided financial donations and sponsorship support to a range of local organizations and initiatives in 2025. Nanaimo Benefits

In 2025, the City of Nanaimo allocated its share of provincial gambling revenue from hosting Casino Nanaimo to the City's Strategic Infrastructure Reserve (SIR) and to offset property taxes. The SIR supports a range of capital projects and community initiatives through annual contributions from both gambling revenue and FortisBC.

In 2025, \$3.2 million from the Strategic Infrastructure Reserve was applied to several community-based projects, including:

- \$1.3 million for the purchase of a new frontline fire apparatus to support the deployment of 20 new firefighters at Fire Station No. 2.
- \$861,015 toward the development of the Harewood Artificial Turf Fields, in partnership with funding from the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program.
- \$564,276 to support property acquisition.
- \$148,000 to support the expansion of the E&N Trail between Columbia Street and Seventh Street, relocating pedestrians, including children travelling to school, away from an active rail line.

Local Impact

In addition to supporting community initiatives, Casino Nanaimo also sources supplies and services from a variety of local vendors including Riverside Painting, Mid Island Fire Equipment, Triple T Party Rentals, and Best on Top Roofing.

Snuneymuxw First Nation Elders' Lunch

BCLC and Casino Nanaimo partnered with Snuneymuxw First Nation to support and serve a special holiday lunch for their Elders. The gathering provided an opportunity to celebrate and honour the Nation's most treasured Elders, while reinforcing the importance of connection, respect, and community. Events like these highlight the positive impact that can be achieved when organizations work together to support meaningful community initiatives.
