Each year, municipal and First Nations governments in B.C. that host a gambling facility typically receive a 10 per cent share of net gambling income generated at those facilities. In fiscal year 2025/26, BCLC generated \$83.4 million for the Province to distribute to 33 Host Local Governments across B.C. to fund local projects and initiatives.

## GAMBLING REVENUE

### Funds Local Initiatives in Terrace

Last year, the Province of B.C. allocated \$140 million to not-for-profit organizations through the Community Gaming Grants program.

## DID YOU KNOW

### Chances Terrace Upgrades

Chances Terrace has completed a major interior renovation project to modernize its facility. The updated gaming floor now features 124 slot machines, a six-seat electronic table game offering Roulette, Blackjack, and Baccarat, as well as introducing four new live tables. The renovation also includes a new Sportsbook lounge equipped with an 18-foot multiscreen and upgraded guest amenities designed to provide a unified atmosphere throughout the property.

## LOCAL IMPACT

### Community Support

In 2025, Chances Terrace made several community donations, including \$15,000 to the Terrace Community Foundation, \$5,000 to Volunteer Terrace, and \$2,500 to the Terrace Riverboat Days Society. An additional \$2,000 was donated to the Kermode Friendship Society and \$1,000 to the Terrace and District Museum Society.

## YOU PLAY

### Terrace Benefits

In 2025, the City of Terrace allocated provincial gambling revenue to several infrastructure projects that contribute to the maintenance and improvement of city services:

- Pavement Overlays: road resurfacing, addressing significant deficiencies like potholes and cracking.
- Sidewalk Resurfacing: sidewalk repairs and improvements to maintain and enhance the condition of city sidewalks.
- Eby Storm Inlet Repairs: repairs to the overflow drainage pipe, reducing the downstream pressure of Howe Creek during significant rain events and preventing localized flooding.
- George Little House Roof Replacement: replacement of the cedar shake shingles at the George Little House, a historic building that serves as Terrace's VIA Rail station.
- Sportsplex Capital Maintenance: replacement of dressing room doors, relocation of the referee room, and upgrading the women's changeroom.

### Terrace Riverboat Days

In 2025, BCLC sponsored Terrace Riverboat Days, the city's annual celebration of Fraser River heritage and community spirit. The multi-day festival included sports events, music, theatre, historical tours and visual art displays as well as a parade, live music, food vendors, artisan markets, family-friendly activities like fireworks over Ferry Island. Concerts in the Park continues to be a highlight at the event and features the best music from around the Northwest. Riverboat Days continues to be an affordable, family-friendly community event.
