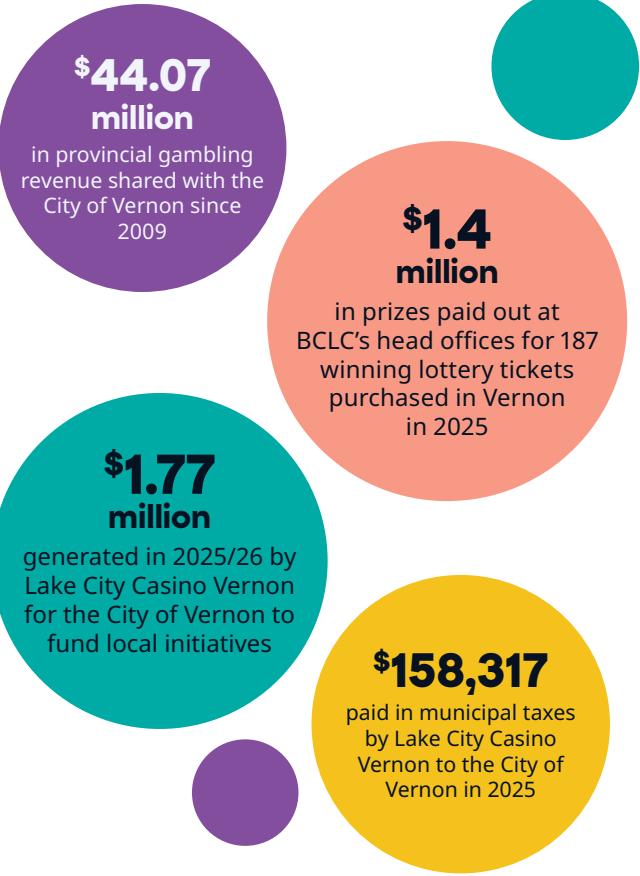
Vernon Community Impact Report

Each year, municipal and First Nations governments in B.C. that host a gambling facility typically receive a 10 per cent share of net gambling income generated at those facilities. In fiscal year 2025/26, BCLC generated \$83.4 million for the Province to distribute to 33 Host Local Governments across B.C. to fund local projects and initiatives.

GAMBLING REVENUE

Funds Local Initiatives in Vernon

Last year, the Province of B.C. allocated \$140 million to not-for-profit organizations through the Community Gaming Grants program.

Vernon Benefits

In 2025, the City of Vernon allocated its share of provincial gambling revenue toward a variety of capital and operating projects. These initiatives included Phase 2 of the Vernon Creek Naturalization Project in Polson Park, water main improvements and taxiway LED upgrades at Vernon Regional Airport, and cemetery irrigation upgrades.

Gambling funds for 2026 will be directed toward Facilities Renewal, with a primary focus on supporting the renewal of the ice system at Kal Tire Place. This project is a key community asset investment that supports recreation, sport tourism, and economic activity in Vernon. A portion is also being used for the new Active Living Centre recreation facility which is on schedule to open in late 2026.

LOCAL IMPACT

Community Support

In 2025, Lake City Casino Vernon supported several community organizations through partnerships and donations. Notable partners included the Archway Society, Easter Seals House Society, Vernon Rotary Club, and Vernon Jubilee Hospital Foundation. Lake City Casino Vernon also donated to Ride for Dad, Bob Brett Memorial Firefighters Golf Tournament, and the Vernon Vipers Hockey Club.
