Each year, municipal and First Nations governments in B.C. that host a gambling facility typically receive a 10 per cent share of net gambling income generated at those facilities. In fiscal year 2025/26, BCLC generated \$83.4 million for the Province to distribute to 33 Host Local Governments across B.C. to fund local projects and initiatives.

Funds Local Initiatives in Greater Victoria

Last year, the Province of B.C. allocated \$140 million to not-for-profit organizations through the Community Gaming Grants program.

View Royal Benefits

In 2025, the Town of View Royal allocated its share of provincial gambling revenue from hosting Casino Victoria to a range of initiatives supporting community services, infrastructure, and public safety. Casino funds supported WestShore Parks and Recreation, grants in aid, and ongoing investments in technology, including annual information systems upgrades and a website refresh.

The revenue also contributed to capital projects such as playground replacement at Knollwood Park and sidewalk improvements on Atkins Road. Significant investments were made in public safety through the purchase of a new fire truck and specialized rescue tools, along with enhancements to emergency program storage.

LOCAL IMPACT

Community Support

In 2025, Casino Victoria supported a wide range of local organizations through charitable donations, in-kind contributions, and sponsorships. A total of \$36,000 in cash donations was distributed to community groups including Kidsport Greater Victoria, Kw'umut Lelum Foundation, Goldstream Food Bank, Extreme Outreach Society, Beacon Community Services, and the Greater Victoria Women's Shelter Society.

Casino Victoria also provided \$13,500 in sponsorships for local community events, including the Victoria Dragon Boat Festival, Viva La WestShore Gala, Best of the WestShore Business Awards, and Colwood Medical Gala.

In addition to supporting community initiatives, Casino Victoria also contributes to the local economy by sourcing supplies and services from a range of local vendors, including Top Line Roofing Ltd., The Sign Pad, Pedersen's Event Rentals, and 4 Seasons Fire Prevention.
