Re: Request for Records: BCLC File 19-014

British Columbia Lottery Corporation (BCLC) writes further to your January 31, 2019 request (received on February 1, 2019) under B.C.'s *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (FIPPA), BCLC's two letters dated February 1, 2019 and your e-mail dated February 1, 2019.

Your original request was for:

"List of names of winners of claimed lottery prizes in BC (prize amount \$1,000,000) for the years 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014."

You clarified this request via e-mail on February 1, 2019 to be for:

"A list of the names of all winners of claimed lottery prizes of \$500,000.00 to \$2,000,000.00 in BC on BC/49, Lotto 6/49, Lotto Max, or any other lottery that offers a prize that falls within the stated range of amounts, from January 1, 2011 to December 31, 2014."

BCLC is withholding six pages of responsive records in their entirety under section 22 of FIPPA, for the reasons that follow.

Section 22 (Disclosure harmful to personal privacy)

The information withheld under this section consists of the personal information of third parties, the disclosure of which would constitute an unreasonable invasion of their personal privacy. BCLC publishes a winner's information for up to two years, starting from the date when the winner is first declared publicly. After this period, BCLC will not publish new material containing a winner's personal information without the winner's consent. BCLC respects the privacy of its winners following the initial period of publishing their information. BCLC's policy on publishing winner information is publicly available at:
