British Columbia Lottery Corporation (BCLC) writes further to your June 19, 2019 request under B.C.'s *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (FIPPA) and BCLC's letter dated June 19, 2019.

You requested:

1. Total number of Suspicious transaction reports filed to fintrac by calendar month from Jan 1, 2015 until Dec 31, 2018.
2. Total dollar value of suspicious transaction reports filed to fintrac by calendar month from Jan 1, 2015 until Dec 31, 2018.

For reference: The current chart on [bclc.com](https://corporate.bclc.com/anti-money-laundering/suspicious-transaction-reports.html) (<https://corporate.bclc.com/anti-money-laundering/suspicious-transaction-reports.html>) with this data is every two months. I require exact same stats except for each month."

In accordance with section 6(2) of FIPPA, BCLC has created a record, enclosed, in response to your request. The record represents the number, and corresponding dollar value with rounded numbers, of STR reports that were submitted by BCLC to FINTRAC monthly for the years 2015 through 2018 inclusive.

BCLC notes that there are some discrepancies between the figures in the record and the chart that is publicly available online at the link that you provided. The statistics have been updated since the chart was published and you may consider the enclosed statistics to be accurate.
