British Columbia Lottery Corporation (BCLC) writes further to your December 15, 2022 request under B.C.'s *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (FIPPA) and BCLC's letter dated December 15, 2022.

You requested:

"Regarding BCLC chair Greg Moore, I seek...copies of all versions of his disclosure of real or apparent or potential conflicts of interest and a copy of his most-recent Gaming Policy and Enforcement Branch registration application and GPEB-issued licence/registration/permit."

BCLC is providing seven records (consisting of 11 pages) in response to your request.

Some information has been withheld from disclosure under sections 15 and 22 of FIPPA.

Below are the reasons for withholding information under each of the exceptions to disclosure noted.

Section 15 (harm to law enforcement)

The information withheld under this section consists of a specific GPEB registration number. Disclosure of this information would be harmful to law enforcement because the GPEB registration number could be used to facilitate fraud or some other type of offence.

Section 22 (harm to personal privacy)

The information withheld under this section consists of personal information of Greg Moore and other third parties. Disclosure of this information would constitute an unreasonable invasion of their personal privacy, including because it could result in identity fraud.

BCLC notes that one of the records it is providing you is a signed version of Appendix A and Appendix B of BCLC's Standards of Ethical Business Conduct (SOEBC). The templated version of SOEBC to which these appendices are appended is available online at the following link:
